



How to Reporting Bullying

The District takes all reports of bullying very seriously and reviews any allegations of such instances to ensure the safety of all students and staff.

Methods for reporting bullying include:

Tell an Adult: Students who are the targets of bullying, their parents, or witnesses are encouraged to tell a school administrator or teacher.

Superintendent's Bullying Hotline: Students who are the targets of bullying, their parents, or witnesses may call (478) 779-3711 and leave a voice message regarding bullying instances. Information that should be provided in the voice message includes the target's full name and the bully's full name, along with the name of the school. The target's name is optional; however, it is helpful to have in order for officials to learn additional details later.

Via the Internet: Students who are the targets of bullying, their parents, or witnesses may visit the District's website, www.bcsdk12.net, and click on the *Let's Talk* icon. On the next page, click on the box marked Bullying/Harassment and follow the steps to provide more information. Information that should be provided includes the target's full name and the bully's full name, along with the name of the school. The target's name is optional; however, it is helpful to have in order for officials to learn additional details later.
