## Weaver Middle School 2023 - 2024 Dress Code Policy

*At Weaver Middle School, each student will demonstrate strength of character and dress for success in preparation for college or career readiness*

Appropriate Attire	Attire Not Permitted
<p><b>Students may wear the following:</b></p> <p><b>PANTS OR SKIRTS (Must have Belt loops):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Plain khaki/black/navy blue pants and plain khaki/black/navy blue skirts</li><li>• <b>Jeans are only permitted on Fridays if students have been present daily and on time</b></li><li>• Shorts may be worn during the spring and summer months – knee length or longer</li><li>• Pants must be of appropriate size, not flare legged, worn as designed and of ankle length. Pants designed to be worn below the top of the hip bone are not allowed.</li><li>• Pants <b>MUST</b> have belt loops and <b>MUST</b> be worn with a belt. • Pants <b>MUST NOT</b> be tucked into shoes or socks.</li><li>• Skirts must be <b>no</b> shorter than two (2) inches above the knee. (Fall Below all the Students fingers)</li><li>• <b>BELTS MUST BE WORN DAILY (ONLY BLACK OR BROWN BELTS) – No Sagging Pants</b></li></ul>	<p><b>Students may NOT wear the following:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Cargo pants are NOT allowed.</li><li>• Tight fitted clothes are NOT allowed.</li><li>• Skirts cannot have any slits or openings.</li><li>• <b>Absolutely No Sagging of Pants</b></li></ul> <p><b>Jewelry</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Dog tags are <b>not</b> allowed</li><li>• Pendants and earrings larger than a quarter and multiple bracelets are <b>not</b> allowed</li><li>• Face Piercings are not allowed</li></ul> <p><b>Hair</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Dyed hair that is not a natural color or shade is <b>not</b> allowed with the exception of scheduled spirit day activities by the school</li><li>• Un-natural hair color includes, but not limited to, hair that is dyed pink, purple, bright red, yellow, blue or green (<b>Not allowed</b>)</li></ul> <p><b>***NO STUDENT CELL PHONES ALLOWED</b></p>
<p><b>SHIRTS/TOPS:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>SOLID COLOR POLO SHIRTS ONLY. NO DESIGNS OR GRAPHICS.</b></li><li>• Polo shirts must have a collar, long or short sleeved</li><li>• <b>SWEATSHIRTS, SWEATERS, OR HOODIES MUST BE SOLID COLORS. NO DESIGNS OR GRAPHICS.</b></li><li>• All shirts must be of appropriate size and must be tucked</li><li>• Plain white undershirts or turtlenecks underneath polo shirts, school t-shirts, sweatshirts and sweaters.</li></ul>	<p><b>***Only Clear or Mesh Bookbags Allowed***</b></p>
<p><b>JACKETS/COATS:</b></p> <p>*Coats <i>must be placed in lockers upon arrival to school</i></p> <p>*Lightweight can be worn in the classroom. <b>SOLID COLORS/JEAN JACKETS ONLY. NO RIPS, FRAYS OR HALF</b></p> <p><b>JACKETS/SWEATSHIRTS</b></p>	<p><b>See the 2023 – 2024 Bibb County Code of Conduct - Consequences listed for not adhering to the dress code policy.</b></p>
<p><b>SHOES/SOCKS:</b></p> <p>Athletic/tennis shoes; SHOE LACES THAT ARE THE APPROPRIATE SIZE FOR THE SHOE ONLY. All shoes must be closed toes (<b>NO HEELS, SLIDES OR CROCKS</b>). Socks are to be worn with the tennis shoes (inappropriate paraphernalia not allowed).</p>	<p><b>We look forward to all students dressing for success!!</b></p>
<p><b>Bookbags – Clear or Mesh Only from Day 1 – Any other type of bag will be confiscated;</b></p>	

Any item prohibited in the Bibb County Board of Education Guidelines for Success or Dress Code is NOT allowed. All items, which in the judgement of the Principal (or designee), disrupts or distracts from the teaching and learning process will not be allowed.
